Ascension Sunday school

This has been a very busy time for Sunday school. Lots of excitement in the air! We have had the good fortune of having Marj Wade, a potter from Stillwater come into Sunday school and help the children make pottery bowls. Each one is incredible and will be on display in the Parish Hall in April. Even the Youth Group has made bowls. Our hope is to raise money for "The Empty Bowl Project" which is an organization that helps hungry children around the world. If we don't donate to them we will to Feed My Starving Children or Heifer International. We will be taking a vote in Sunday school after Easter and will let you know when they are on display. Each bowl will be \$20.00 which some of that money will go to Marj Wade for her supplies and the rest to the organization that the children pick.

We're making Resurrection Rolls again this year! Mary Duke and Sally Giese's class have done this for quite a few years and now all of the children want to make them so this will happen in stages on March 30th. Just go to your Sunday school class and we will take you in groups up to the kitchen.

Recipe for Resurrection Rolls

Butter, Cinnamon, Sugar, Marshmallows & refrigerator (frozen) Dinner Rolls !

The story goes like this. You take the dinner roll that is no longer frozen and shape it into a disk. The marshmallow is pure and white which represents Jesus. The melted butter and cinnamon and sugar represent the oils and spices used to anoint Jesus after he died. Dip the marshmallow in the butter. Place it on the dinner roll. Sprinkle with cinnamon and sugar. Seal the dough around the marshmallow. This signifies the way Jesus was sealed in the tomb. Bake the roll for 12-15 minutes. Allow to cool before serving. When you break open the roll, it is empty, like the tomb on Easter morning.

Glazing of our Pottery Bowls will happen in class on April 6th. This is something else we will have to do in stages as there are many children that will need to glaze their final project. Just go to your regular class and we will bring you where you need to go. room during Sunday school time (9-10 am) on April 6th, 13th & 27th (Not on the 20th as Youth Choir sings) and then on May 4th & 11th.
